Year End Finance Report.

The church fiscal year ended on June 30th. I will share the year end financial report in August. It was another good year financially for us and we will finish the year with surplus. I wish to thank you for your generous support of Saint Peters. I spoke about this the past Sunday when I said that our parish family is a disciple parish and your generosity enables us to carry out our mission to bring Jesus Christ to the Nations.

Ignite

The Ignite Diocesan campaign will begin in August. I will be calling many of you to help with this campaign. The goal for Saint Peters is \$740,000.00. This is a three year campaign so the goal is \$250,000.00 each year. If we reach our goal we receive 17% of the money back to the parish. If we exceed our goal we receive 75% of the surplus money to the parish. I will write more later as I think I have an easy process for us to reach our goal.

Children's Liturgy.

We are in need to people to help with children's liturgy. The children's liturgy takes place on Sunday morning during the 10:00 a.m. mass.
