A Magnificent Celebration.

I spoke about this on Sunday in my homily but it is an important reflection. One of the hardest things is to lose priests who are active in the ministry. This past week we lost two of our priests, Father David Smith and Father Dan Gehler. These priests served in Harlan, Earling, Definace, Westphalia, Portsmouth and Panama, Iowa. The funeral celebration for Father Gehler was a great moment of God's grace. There were 82 priests who attended the service and forty deacons because Father Gehler had been a permanent deacon in our Diocese before he became a priest. There were over 600 people who attended the funeral. The thing about this funeral liturgy that was inspiring was to see the great love and appreciation that the people had for their priests. When I think about this I also think about the fact that it will be difficult to find replacements for these two wonderful priests. I said this Sunday and I will repeat this please pray for Bishop Joensen as he has the difficult task of finding priests who will serve the people of Shelby County. Please pray for all priests that they take good care of themselves.




