#### Ash Wednesday Mass Schedule.

The Tuesday evening mass is at 5:30 p.m.

The Ash Wednesday mass schedule is as follows: 8:00 a.m. Noon and 6:15 p.m. The 6:15 p.m. mass is intended for all the Wednesday evening religious education students and the public school students in confirmation.

### Lenten Devotion Schedule.

One of the most important aspects of Lent is that we all grow in the graces that living the Lent devotions offers us. In my years at Saint Peters the Lenten devotions are a great time for all of us to grow in our Catholic faith.

The mass schedule will be a little different once that Lent starts. The daily masses will be as follows: The Wednesday and Friday masses will be at 8:00 a.m. The Thursday mass will be at 5:30 p.m. I haven't decided if we will have these masses in church or in the social hall. The social hall has served us well during these winter months.

The Tuesday evening mass, stations of the cross and soup supper will begin at 5:30 p.m. The mass and devotions will be in the church. The soup supper and program will be in the social hall. I urge everyone to come to the Tuesday mass and program it is a great way to grow in your understanding to the teachings of the church and to deepen our understanding of the scriptures.

The Friday stations of the cross and benediction will be held in the church at 5:30 p.m. These devotions are also a wonderful avenue to grow in the grace of Jesus Christ. One of the most wonderful things about Lent, especially at Saint Peters, is that when Easter is celebrated we can all rejoice that we have taken advantage of the many opportunities to grow in Jesus' grace.

#### Lenten Materials.

On the table in the front of the church are the Lenten materials. These materials will help you have a very spiritual Lent. There are Lenten materials for every age group.

For the young children there is a coloring book entitled: "Follow Me."

For Junior and Senior high school students is the book: "Light for Our Path".

This year we have a Lenten family book: "Lent in Real Life." This is a new program that we are offering that will help families grow together as a sign of Jesus' presence to the world.

For the adults: "A Season of Deep and Everlasting Healing." This book is an individual guide to a deeper relationship with Jesus. There is also the book: "Praying with Jesus this Lent". This book is a guide to celebrate the daily mass readings each day.

There is also a medal that you can put on your car keys that will help remind you that you are in the Lenten season. All of these materials are for your spiritual growth in the Lenten season.

#### Soup Suppers.

The sign up sheets for the soup suppers are on the tables in the front and the back of the church. I encourage you come to all five of these soup suppers. You will grow in your knowledge of the scriptures and the teachings of the church.
