Holy Week Mass Schedule.

The Holy Week mass schedule is as follows:

The masses on Palm Sunday follow the regular Sunday schedule.

The mass of the Lord's supper, Holy Thursday mass will be at 7:00 p.m. There will be adoration of the Blessed Sacrament after the conclusion of the mass until 9:00 p.m. I encourage everyone to spend some time in prayer before the blessed sacrament as a preparation for Good Friday and Easter Sunday.

The Good Friday services will be at noon and 7:00 p.m. These services are the only services that are not a mass but are the reading of the passion and communion.

Easter Sunday: Holy Saturday Evening mass is at 6:00 p.m. Please note the change in time. This is the most important mass of the church year as it celebrates the resurrection of Jesus. We will be receiving two people into our parish family and so I encourage you to attend this mass so that we welcome these two wonderful people into our parish family.

The Easter Sunday mass schedule is the regular Sunday, 8:00 a.m., 10:00 a.m. and Noon. I encourage you to spend some time in prayer as a preparation for the most grace filled and important week of the church year.

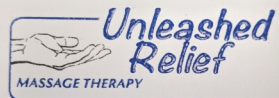
