Oktoberfest Dinner Tickets

I hope this explanation will help you to understand our Oktoberfest dinner tickets situation. The reason for me writing this is to clarify our needs. We need an accurate count for the number of people from our parish family that will be eating the Oktoberfest meal. Litterdale cathering prepares the meal and they charge us \$13.00 for each meal so we need an accurate count. If our count is not accurate then we have to pay for each meal even if people do not attend the dinner. What I am asking you to do is this: When you buy your tickets for Oktoberfest, KEEP YOUR DINNER TICKETS, but mark on the return sheet that you have purchased your dinner tickets and that you will be eating the dinner. I made a great mistake last year and over estimated the number of people attending the dinner, thus it costs us over \$4,000.00 since we have to pay for all the dinners. If you have any questions about this please contact the office and we will explain it. I am hoping that we have close to 600 dinners as that would be a great improvement to the number of people attending Oktoberfest.

Oktoberfest Worker Sign Up.

We will again have the sign up to work Oktoberfest this Sunday. I spoke about this last Sunday that when we work together that we grow together as a parish family. The form to sign up is three pages long and there are many opportunities to help with Oktoberfest.

Oktoberfest tickets.

The Oktoberfest tickets are on the table in the back of the church. Please pick them after mass and return them as soon as possible. I believe that we have one of the best raffles this year and the prizes are something that everyone can use and enjoy.

Music Ministry.

One of the most important ministries is the music ministry. We are so blest to have three different music groups in our music ministry. Steve Beck is our parish organist, we have the four o'clock music group and we have the 10:00 a.m. music ministry. If you have music talent and would like to share this talent with us please contact me at the office. It is so important for our parish family for all of us to use our talents to proclaim the goodness of Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior.

A Special Bishop
