Diocesan Appeal.

We are entering our third week of the Diocesan appeal. We have quite a number of people who have not made their pledge to the appeal. The target amount is \$275.00 or \$15.00 more than you did last year. I have said this each week and it needs repeating. The goal we have for this years appeal is \$74,169.00 which is an increase of \$4,952.00. This is the greatest challenge that we have had in all my years. If you do not make your pledge you will receive either a phone call or a letter asking you to make you pledge. If everyone does their part we will reach our goal. If we exceed our goal we will receive the excess money. In the past years we have received over \$5,000.00 for exceeding our goal.

Lent is Flying By.

It is difficult to believe but Lent is half over. My question to you is how are your Lenten practices going? I wish to encourage you to attend one or both of our special Lenten spiritual programs. First, if you have not come to the Tuesday evening program, mass, stations of the cross, soup supper and the Lenten program which begins at 5:30 p.m. There are only two weeks left for this Lenten activity. I also encourage you to attend stations of the cross and benediction on Friday at 5:30 p.m. in the church. One of the saddest things is to realize that Lent has passed us by and we do not take advantage of any of the Lenten programs in the parish. I also encourage you to attend one daily mass. The one mass that is most convenient is the Thursday evening mass at 5:30 p.m.

Altar Society.

It is wonderful to have the Altar Society meeting again. We are so blest to have an altar society and I encourage all women of the parish to attend.

Sign Up For Holy Week.

On the table in the front of the church are the signup sheets for Holy Week. We will need ministers for the Good Friday, Holy Saturday and the 8, 10 and Noon Easter Sunday masses. You have been so good in the past about signing up for these ministries that I hope the same holds true for this year. This will be my last Holy Week with you so I hope this Holy Week is a great celebration.

Sacrament of Reconciliation

This is a reminder that next week that the sacrament of reconciliation will be celebrated after all of the masses. One of the most important things about the Lenten season is that we make it a true penitential season by celebrating Jesus' forgiveness for us. The regular scheduled time for reconciliation is every Saturday from 3:00 p.m. to 3:35. You may also schedule reconciliation at any time by calling the office and setting up a time for reconciliation. So often I feel that celebrating the sacrament of reconciliation is one of the forgotten sacrament in our church and yet it is the greatest sacrament of conversion in our church.

<u>Shrimp Dinner</u>

This Friday March 15 the Knights of Columbus will host a shrimp dinner from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. in the social hall. We served over 270 people at the last shrimp dinner and we hope to serve over 300 this Friday. The important thing to remember is that fish is fine but shrimp is divine.
