I am very pleased with the cemetery collection, over \$800.00 was raised for the cemetery. We are planning on taking up a collection from all the parishes to help fund the cemetery.

The training of altar servers will be different this year than in the past. The best way to train an altar server is to have them shadow, which means that the server being trained will be on the altar with the regular server and thus they can observe what the altar servers do.

Fifty Four Years.

This Thursday June 6th will be my 54th anniversary of ordination to the priesthood. I don't reflect often but since this is my last month before my retirement I am going to share a few thoughts about being a priest in today's world. First, it is very sad to see what has happened to the church in the past 54 years. My first years in the priesthood it was exciting because of the number of people attending mass on the weekends. The church were filled with families and especially the children. To see how we have lost this is tragic. I feel so often that we have so many people who have lost their faith and in the process have lost their moral compass. Second, the number of priests has declined drastically. When I first came to Saint Peters there were ten priest in Council Bluffs, today there are five active priests in Council Bluffs. I read recently that the number of priests world wide is less than half it was twenty years ago. Third, the church has gotten older. Many times people have observed that many of the organizations have very few young members and at Saint Peters I am very aware of this. Fourth, there is tremendous financial pressure on a parish if the parish is part of a school system. One of the great challenges of this parish is to raise over \$400,000.00 every year to meet our financial obligation to Saint Albert. The Diocesan Appeal has risen to over \$75,000.00 every year which has become a great challenge for us to meet this obligation, the past two years we have not meet our Diocesan Appeal goal. My last observation is that there are far more joys in the priest hood than there are heartaches, so pray a prayer for me as I end my active ministry.
