All Saints' Day

God is glorious in His Saints!

In the holiness of God's Saints we see His victory played out in every age, every nation, and every state of life. Jesus's resurrection truly has won a new life for us, and the Saints prove it to us again and again by the beautiful lives they lead on Earth.

The Saints are a guide to us. They have walked the "narrow way" ahead of us and made the path clearer for us to follow. I can look to dozens of priest saints in all sorts of situations for examples and advice. There are so many married men and women, children, doctors, builders, etc etc to show us the way to be holy and joyful in whatever situation we find ourselves in.

The Saints are our cheerleaders and friends. As we "run the race" in this life we have a whole stadium of Saints cheering us on, encouraging us, and helping us with their prayers.

The Saints are our destiny, please God. Jesus came to make us great Saints, if only we'll follow Him completely. The Saints challenge us to fully live the Gospel in our lives here on Earth.

We celebrate All Saints' Day both for all the saints together and because the Saints are "a great crowd that no one could count"—we don't claim to know who they all are, so we celebrate this great festival to include all of them.

This year All Saints' Day falls on Friday.

It is a Holy Day of Obligation for all Catholics, like a Sunday.

Death is a horrible thing. Even while we celebrate the glory of the Saints in heaven, we also mourn that death separates us from our loved ones here on Earth for now, and that it ends our Earthly lives.

Jesus has won the victory over death, but he did not do so by abolishing it for us here on Earth. By the cross He made a way *through* it to eternal life. I can be full of hope for those who have died, even while I miss them and mourn their death.

We pray for the dead because we continue to love them, because we have hope for their eternal life, and because we are mourning the end of their earthly life. We pray for the dead to help them on their journey through death to life.

Maybe our dead relatives and friends have already arrived at the "end of the road" in heaven. They don't need our prayers to help them, but God always makes good use of anything we do for love.

Many of our relatives and friends are probably still "on the way" to the glory of heaven—Jesus tells us that we must be perfect to enter! Our prayers help them on the way and are how we love them now.

This year all Saints' Day falls on Saturday.

It is not a day of obligation, but is a beautiful day to fulfill our obligation to pray for the dead.
