## From Father Jacob

#### Prepare the way of the Lord!

We prepare for the coming of the Lord the same way we prepare for anyone to come.

- 1. We clean: spiritually we examine our lives, ask forgiveness, and go to confession. We talked about this the first week of Advent.
- 2. We make space: we might need to move things around in our lives and hearts to make space for the Lord. We talked about this the second week of Advent.
- 3. We decorate: we adorn our lives with beautiful good works and loving acts to prepare for our guest, the Lord. We will talk about that this Sunday, the Third Sunday of Advent

#### Decorate

When we are celebrating or having people over we want to decorate our homes. We want to make it clear that what is happening is important and bring our best.

As we prepare to celebrate the coming of the Lord we want to do the same. How do we decorate our souls, our hearts, our lives for the Lord? *By our acts of devotion, generosity, and good works done for love of God we adorn and beautify our lives.* 

All of us can think of a time we did something really beautiful. Maybe it was a wise word that came to you to comfort someone. Maybe it is a habit of reading the scriptures you have cultivated. Maybe it is a generous commitment you have made of time, work, or money to a good cause. These things beautify our lives and, if we do them with love of God, they beautify our souls for the Lord as well!

With God's help, we can live beautiful lives and have beautiful souls, ready to welcome the coming of the Lord.
