

From Father Jacob

Death is swallowed up in victory. Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?

Jesus has removed the sting of death. I do not have to fear it anymore. He has not done this by abolishing it in this life; I will still have to die. Rather he has gone through death and made a way through it for me to be with him. He has given me hope (confident expectation of a future good) in Him and in life eternal. A Christian goes to meet his or her eventual death as a conqueror, not as a slave like the rest of the world.

This can, and should, change the way I approach every aspect of my life, since every moment my life since my birth has been touched by my eventual death. Almost everything we do in the world *apart from Christ* will eventually be lost, but *in Christ*:

Therefore, my beloved brothers and sisters, be firm, steadfast, always fully devoted to the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain.

In Christ nothing is lost. In Christ the smallest act of love has been united to eternity and the source of goodness and love itself. In Christ I, too, am eternal, and a victor over sin and death.

Thanks be to God who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

This year we are marking the Jubilee of Hope, a special year of God's mercy and forgiveness. We have discussed that in this jubilee year there are special graces available in the form of indulgences attached to pilgrimages to churches and holy sites, prayer and devotions, penances, and catechetical programs (like our soup suppers). 
