#### PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

# From Father Jacob

#### My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?

Sometimes the way we sing this psalm can leave us with the impression that the Father did actually abandon the Son on the cross, or that the abandonment is the end of the story. But Jesus *is* God. He cannot abandon Himself. Jesus quotes this psalm because it so fully describes his situation. Let's pay special attention to how this psalm ends:

For he has not spurned or disdained the misery of this poor wretch, Did not turn away from me, but heard me when I cried out... The poor will eat their fill; those who seek the LORD will offer praise... All the ends of the earth will remember and turn to the LORD: All the families of nations will bow low before him... All who sleep in the earth will bow low before God: All who have gone down into the dust will kneel in homage. And I will live for the LORD; my descendants will serve you. The generation to come will be told of the Lord, that they may proclaim to a people yet unborn the deliverance you have brought.

## **Holy Week and Easter**

In this most solemn week, the whole Church commemorates the suffering, death, and resurrection of Our Lord by which he has saved us.

Tuesday and Wednesday: 8am Mass

**Holy Thursday:** 6pm Mass, followed by adoration "in the garden" until 10pm

On Holy Thursday we celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper. We commemorate the Lord's loving service to his friends by the washing of the feet. We commemorate his institution of the Eucharist in his sharing of his Body and Blood. We celebrate the Church's mission of worship in his command "do this in memory of me". Afterwards we accompany the Lord into the "garden" and keep watch with him as he asked us to.

Good Friday: Noon - stations of the cross

1-3pm - live reenacted stations at Corpus Christi

6pm - Liturgy

On Good Friday we fast and pray with the Lord who suffered and died for us. We will have the stations of the cross at noon in the church. Everyone is invited and encouraged to participate in the live reenacted stations of the cross conducted at Corpus Christi starting at 1pm. Our Parish Liturgy of the Lord's Passion will be at 6pm.

Easter Vigil: 8pm

At the Easter Vigil we watch and pray through the night, to be awake at the unknown hour when Jesus, the light of the world, broke through the darkness and rose from the tomb! Our candidates and catechumens will be brought into the Church at this beautiful service.

Easter Sunday: 8am, 10am, noon

Come celebrate the Lord's resurrection!


