Novena for the Holy Spirit

When he ascended into heaven, Jesus told his apostles to:

wait for "the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

This 9-day wait for the Holy Spirit became the very first Novena, the nine days of prayer between Jesus's Ascension and the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Christians should always ask to be strengthened by the Holy Spirit, who God has given to us at Baptism and Confirmation. This time before Pentecost is a beautiful time to renew that request.

We will celebrate the Ascension on Sunday this year, but if you want to pray the nine days of waiting for the Holy Spirit you will need to start on Friday, May 30th.

In our nine days we will pray for the fruits of the Holy Spirit: Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control, and goodness (see Galatians 5:22-23). You can do this in any way you like, below is a very appropriate prayer to use:

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth.

O, God, who instruct the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations, through Christ Our Lord, Amen.


